OVERVIEW OF PROJECT

Limits: I-27 from Western Street to the US 60/US 87 interchange

CSJs: 0168-09-148, 0168-09-173, 0067-14-033

Proposed Project: The proposed improvements consist of widening I-27 from four to six lanes (three lanes in each direction), improving ramps and frontage roads, reconstructing and improving bridges over intersecting cross streets, and providing bike and pedestrian accommodations. The purpose of the proposed project is to reduce congestion and improve mobility and safety by providing additional roadway capacity. Additionally, this project is proposed to meet future traffic demands due to population growth and increased traffic volumes within Amarillo and in the connection to Canyon.
