2023 - 2026 Rural Transportation Improvement Program Revision

AMARILLO DISTRICT

May 2024 Revision

The Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) Amarillo District is conducting a virtual meeting beginning Monday, April 15, 2024, at 9 a.m. The purpose of this meeting is to provide updates and receive comments on proposed revisions to the 2023-2026 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The projects in TxDOT's Amarillo District affected by the revision include adding:

- CSJ: 0238-06-039, US 54 in Sherman County (At County Road 9)
- CSJ: 0090-04-069, IH 40 in Oldham County (East Bound Lane near MM 40)

The 2023-2026 Rural TIP meeting was held in the spring of 2022 pursuant to *Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102*, which calls for an opportunity for public comment concerning the program. As a continuation of the public involvement effort, the online comment opportunity will offer the public a chance to comment on the revision to the previously presented Rural TIP.
