Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option
US 54 Expansion
From FM 2677 to the Oklahoma State Line

The Texas Department of Transportation is proposing the expansion of US 54 from FM 2677 to the Oklahoma State Line in Sherman County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting in-person and virtual public meetings to receive public comments on the proposed project. All meetings will present the same information, and the in-person attendees will be able to see a presentation discussing the proposed project, review exhibits and displays of the proposed project, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. In addition to the in-person meeting, TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project. The virtual public meeting can be viewed beginning Tuesday, Nov. 14, 2023 at noon. The virtual public meeting is not a live event and the materials can be viewed at your convenience. The virtual public meeting will consist of a presentation explaining the proposed project, along with other exhibits and materials for your review. The virtual public meeting materials will be posted to www.txdot.gov, keyword search "US 54 Expansion" on Tuesday, Nov. 14, 2023 and will remain available online through the comment period deadline of Monday, Dec. 4, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. If you do not have internet access, you may call 806-356-3299 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process. Comments may be provided by mail, email, or voicemail as explained below. Please note that the materials will not be available until Tuesday, Nov. 14, 2023 at noon.

TxDOT is developing design schematics, environmental documents and studies for US 54 from FM 2677 to the Oklahoma State Line in Sherman County, Texas. The project aims to upgrade US 54 from a 2-lane undivided roadway to a 4-lane divided roadway with a median. The project will evaluate improvements to cross streets and will remove existing rest stops and consolidate these areas to one new truck parking location. These improvements will help increase the overall safety of the corridor and add capacity.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling 806-356-3299.

The virtual public meeting and in-person option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting or in-person option, please contact Jason Britsch, at 806-672-8585 no later than 4 p.m. CT, Friday, Nov. 10, 2023. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for TxDOT to arrange.

All comments must be received on or before Monday, Dec. 4, 2023. Responses to comments received will be available online at www.txdot.gov, keyword search "US 54 Expansion" once they have been prepared.
