This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed US 87 Expansion Project and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project includes expanding the roadway from the current two-lane with super-two passing lanes into a four-lane divided highway along US 87 from east of the US 385 Interchange, near Hartley, to FM 2589 west of Dumas in Moore and Hartley counties, Texas. This project is approximately 19 miles long.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at Amarillo District Office at 5715 Canyon Drive, Amarillo, Texas 79110, telephone # (806) 356-3200.
