



Notice of 2022 Virtual Public Hearing

Atlanta District

Available for Viewing at 4 p.m. on Monday, Dec. 12, 2022

In accordance with Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, Part 1, Chapter 25, Subchapter D, Rule §25.55 (a) and (b), the Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) Atlanta District will conduct a virtual public hearing to include a pre-recorded presentation containing both audio and visual components on **Monday, Dec. 12, 2022**. **This is not a live event. The virtual hearing will be available online beginning at 4 p.m. at www.txdot.gov, search for Atlanta 2022 Virtual Annual Bicycle Hearing. Please note that the materials will not be available until Dec. 12, 2022.**

The purpose of this hearing is to provide information regarding transportation projects and programs that might affect bicycle-use on the state system within the Atlanta District. The Atlanta District consists of Bowie, Camp, Cass, Harrison, Marion, Morris, Panola, Titus, and Upshur counties. A presentation showing bicycle and pedestrian roadway accommodations will be shown during the virtual hearing, and the public will have the opportunity to provide verbal or written comments by phone, mail, or email.

Comments from the public regarding the district transportation projects and programs that might affect bicycle use on the state highway system are requested and can be submitted online, by email to Jason.Overmyer@txdot.gov, or by mail to **TxDOT Atlanta District Office, Attn: Jason Overmyer, 701 E. Main St., Atlanta, TX 75551**. Verbal comments may be submitted by calling and leaving a voicemail at (903) 224-8390. All comments must be received or postmarked on or before **Friday, Dec. 30, 2022**. Responses to written comments received and public testimony provided will be made available online at www.txdot.gov once they have been prepared.

The 2022 Virtual Annual Bicycle Hearing will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
