



Notice of Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option

I-20 Widening Project

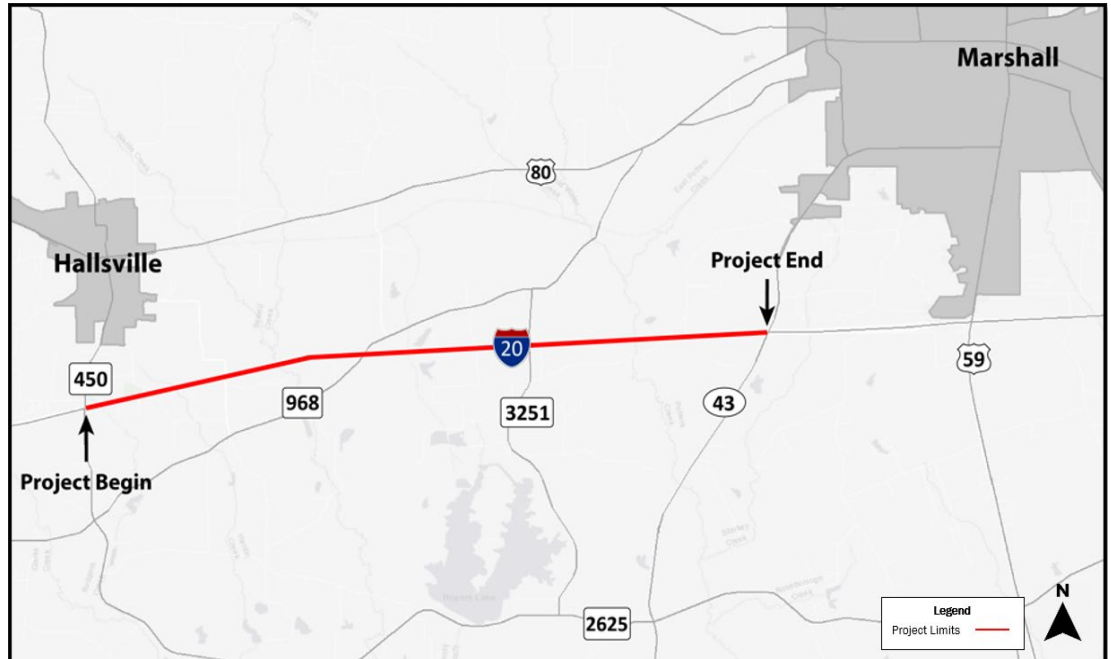

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) proposes reconstruction and widening of I-20 from FM 450 to SH 43 in Harrison County, Texas. The approximate 10-mile roadway will be reconstructed to widen the existing interstate from four lanes to six lanes and construct one-way frontage roads. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person option.

The virtual meeting will be posted online **Tuesday, Feb. 22, 2022 by 12 p.m. (noon)**. To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address after the date and time indicated above: www.txdot.gov. Search: **I-20 Hallsville to Marshall**. The virtual public meeting will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until at least Wednesday, March 9, 2022. If you do not have internet access, you may call (903) 799-1309 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.



Additionally, TxDOT is providing the in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to review hard copies of the project materials and ask questions of the TxDOT staff and consultants from an appropriate social distance and leave written comments. The in-person option will be held on **Tuesday, Feb. 22, 2022 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Hallsville Junior High School Cafeteria, 1 Bobcat Ln., Hallsville, TX 75650**.

The purpose of the proposed project is to reconstruct and widen I-20 from two lanes to three lanes in each direction to increase the capacity. This will improve regional mobility and address pavement deficiencies on this major corridor. Proposed improvements along I-20 from FM 450 to SH 43 will include construction of one-way frontage roads, construction of new entrance and exit ramps from Galilee Rd to FM 968, and upgrades to grade separated interchanges. The proposed project is anticipated to require approximately 57 acres of new right of way.

All comments must be received or postmarked on or before Wednesday, March 9, 2022.

The virtual public meeting with an in-person option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the Texas Department of Transportation to arrange.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated Dec. 9, 2019, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
