2021 - 2024 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP) Revision
Atlanta District

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will be conducting a virtual public meeting for the proposed 2021-2024 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP) Revision for the Atlanta TxDOT District.

The virtual public meeting pre-recorded presentation will be available for viewing on Friday, Jan. 28, 2022 by 12 p.m. This virtual meeting format (no in-person meeting) includes a pre-recorded video presentation and comment opportunity. The presentation will include both audio and visual components.

The purpose of this virtual public meeting is to receive comments on the proposed revision to the project that was approved in the 2021-2024 Rural TIP, which was presented on June 25, 2020. On that date, the Atlanta TxDOT District presented the proposed 2021-2024 Rural TIP for its nine counties. The Atlanta District includes Bowie, Cass, Marion, Harrison, Panola, Titus, Morris, Camp, and Upshur counties. The project was moved from fiscal year 2021 to fiscal year 2022 through Administrative Modification in November 2021 Revision. This proposed February 2022 Revision to the project includes increased construction cost.

The project listed in the approved 2021-2024 Rural TIP, modified in the November 2021 Revision, and proposed to be revised in the February 2022 Revision is:

CSJ 0520-05-040, SH 155 in Upshur County (From 0.3 MI E of US 259 To Glendia Drive)

The Rural TIP includes all regionally significant projects to be funded within a TxDOT District during the next four years, including those eligible for funding. As such, this meeting will offer the public an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed revision.

The 2021-2024 Rural TIP Revision meeting is being held pursuant to *Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102*, which calls for an opportunity for public comment concerning the program. Presentation materials will show the project being proposed to be revised from the previously proposed Rural TIP and modification.
