

Welcome

Welcome to the Texas Department of Transportation Atlanta District's Virtual Public Meeting with in-person option for the proposed State Loop 390 / US Highway 59 Relief Route, and future Interstate 369 project. We appreciate your attendance.

The proposed project limits are from 0.7 mile north of US Highway 80 to 1.2 miles south of Interstate Highway 20 in Harrison County, Texas. The proposed project length is approximately 6 miles.

The purpose of the proposed project is to provide a continuous access-controlled roadway that would:

- Meet interstate design standards and be designated as State Loop 390, US 59 Relief Route, and, ultimately, Interstate 369 (I-369)
- Enhance safety and improve mobility and connectivity for local and through traffic, and
- Improve freight mobility through the Marshall area

This Project is Needed because:

- US 59 is the designated route for I-369
- I-369 is an interstate spur in Texas extending from Tenaha to Texarkana
- The entire I-69 system in Texas is part of the Texas Highway Freight Network and
- US 59 is a Hurricane Evacuation Route through Harrison County

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an update on the project, allow you to review the recommended preferred alternative, and for you to provide comments and feedback. A Comment Station with additional information is included as the last station in the meeting room.

Instructions

So first, let's go over some virtual room navigation instructions. To get around in the meeting room, click and hold your mouse (on a computer) or use your fingers (smart phone or tablet).

To zoom in and out, you can scroll your mouse backwards or forwards.

To zoom in on a board in a station, move your mouse or finger over the board and click the magnifying glass.

Please note that the proposed design for the Recommended Preferred Alternative is a preliminary design and subject to change as the project moves forward. The final constructed project may differ based on a number of factors.

The schematic provides information about potential property impacts as a result of proposed changes to right-of-way to accommodate the project. The pink lines are the existing right-of-way, and the blue lines are the proposed right-of-way. The file is best viewed when you download the .pdf and use the name signs to zoom into the general vicinity of your property. From there, you can locate your (or the property owner's) name and zoom in further to view details.
