SL 390/US 59 RELIEF ROUTE (FUTURE I-369)

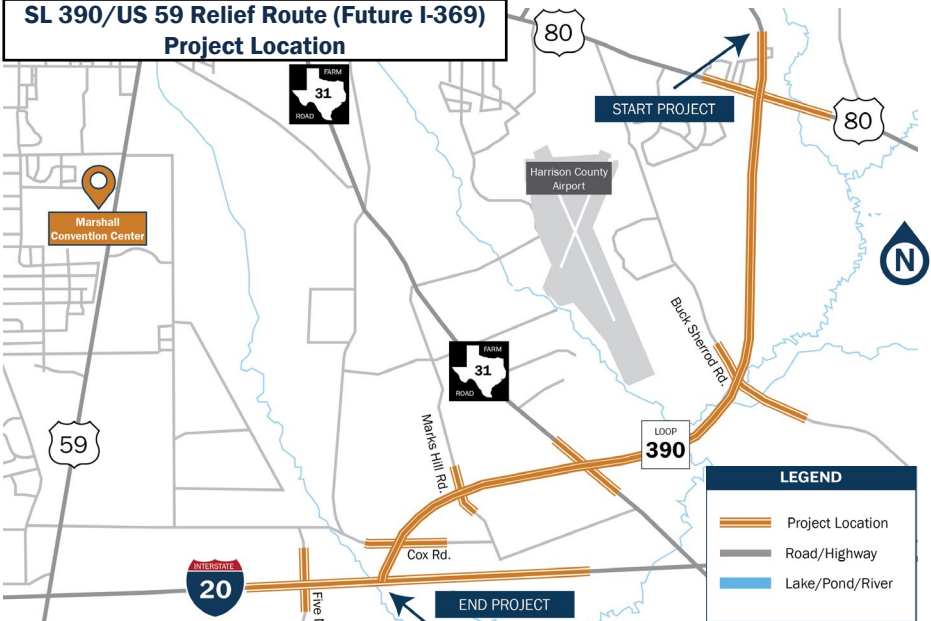
VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING WITH IN-PERSON OPTION

TxDOT is holding a virtual public meeting with in-person option to present the revised design for the SL 390/US 59 Relief Route on the east side of Marshall in Harrison County, Texas. The project would be constructed on a new location and extend from 0.7 mile north of US 80 to I-20. The project would be designed to interstate standards and eventually become part of the future I-369, part of the I-69 system through Texas. The improvements would also include approximately three miles of I-20 from 0.55 mile east of US 59 to FM 31/Elysian Fields Road.

This public meeting will present the latest project design, which has been revised since the August 2021 public meeting.

- Proposed improvements include the construction of:
- A new location, controlled access freeway
 - One-way frontage roads
 - On- and off-ramps
 - Overpass bridges
 - Underpasses
 - A double roundabout
