WHY IMPROVEMENTS ARE NEEDED

SH 71 serves as a major corridor for drivers traveling to and from the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport, the city of Bastrop, and other Central Texas communities. With continued growth in Travis and Bastrop counties, TxDOT is improving SH 71 to enhance safety and address congestion by eliminating signalized intersections.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The proposed project is needed to address congestion along SH 71 due to increased population growth and traffic volumes. The purpose of the proposed project is to improve mobility and reduce congestion along SH 71 at Tucker Hill Lane and includes:

- A new overpass bridge on SH 71 over the existing signalized intersection at Tucker Hill Lane.
- New one-way frontage roads within the project limits.
- Improved and expanded bicycle and pedestrian accommodations.

The project requires 24.5 acres of right of way at the Tucker Hill Lane intersection. No displacements are anticipated for the proposed project.

The anticipated construction start date for this project is October 2025.
