

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) proposes to improve 7.2 miles of FM 2720 from SH 21 to SH 142 in Hays and Caldwell counties, Texas, including intersection improvements at CR 235.

The purpose of the proposed project is to enhance safety, improve connectivity and improve mobility by providing additional roadway capacity to meet current and future traffic demands due to population growth and increased traffic volumes. These improvements are consistent with TxDOT's statewide plan to upgrade FM 2720 to add mainlanes and shoulders.

Throughout the project limits, the existing roadway is two lanes. The preliminary plans would:

- Widen the roadway to a:
 - Four-lane undivided roadway with a center two-way left-turn lane from SH 21 to south of CR 228.
 - Four-lane divided roadway from south of CR 228 to just south of CR 235.
 - Two-lane roadway with a center two-way left-turn lane from south of CR 235 to SH 142.
- Separate travel lanes by adding a two-way left-turn lane or grassy median with cable barrier.
- Add right-turn lanes at various intersections.
- Add safety improvements to the intersection at CR 235.
- Upgrade the signal at SH 21 and FM 2720.

An in-person public meeting will be held on Thursday, June 1, 2023, from 5 p.m. – 7 p.m., at the Lockhart Junior High School, located at 500 City Line Road, Lockhart, TX 78644. Attendees may come and go at their convenience, there will be no formal presentation. In-person attendees will have the opportunity to view the displays presented in the virtual public meeting, ask questions of TxDOT staff, and leave written comments.

Comments must be postmarked or received by Friday June 16, 2023.

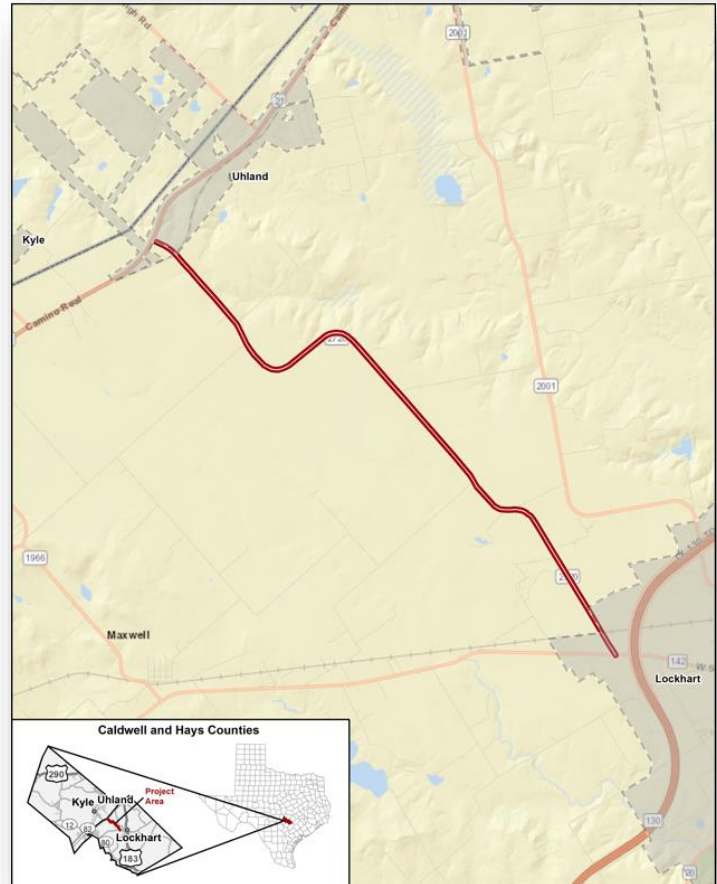
