

# FM 812 Improvement Project

Limits: From US 183 in Travis County to SH 21 in Bastrop County

## Project Overview

### Project CSJ:

1149-01-023 & 1149-02-026

**Project Length:** FM 812: 9.49 miles; FM 973: 0.75 miles

**Right of Way:** 174 acres of new right of way and 2.4 acres of permanent easements.

**Project Cost:** \$145 million

### Project Need:

The FM 812 corridor between US 183 and SH 21 is experiencing significant growth. The roadway does not meet current design standards, resulting in mobility and safety challenges, which will only worsen due to continued development. Upgrades are needed to improve safety and mobility and reduce congestion.

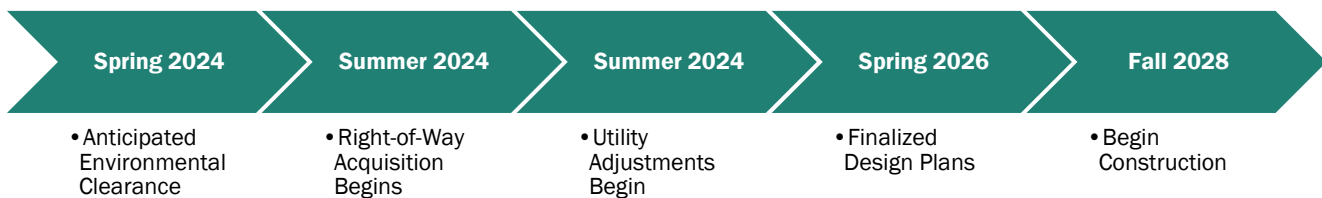
### Project Purpose:

The purpose of the proposed project is to upgrade FM 812 to current design standards to improve safety and reduce congestion, and to improve mobility.

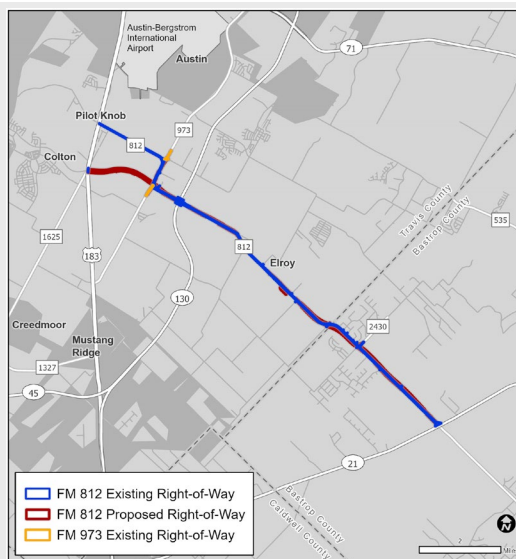
### Proposed Improvements:

- Reconstructing the existing roadway to a four-lane undivided roadway with a continuous left-turn lane from US 183 to Peterson Road in the town of Elroy and a four-lane divided roadway from Peterson Road to SH 21.
- Constructing a 1.46-mile new location section of FM 812 from US 183 to FM 973 that connects FM 812 with the William Cannon Drive intersection at US 183.
- Adding shared-use paths for bicyclists and pedestrians.
- Constructing new drainage along the corridor.
- Upgrading four bridges along FM 812 and one on FM 973.
