This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed FM 3349 at US 79 project, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would include widening the existing undivided two-lane FM 3349 and CR 101 roadways into a four-lane divided roadway, constructing an elevated crossing over US 79 and the Union Pacific Railroad, and constructing a local access road "jug handle" to provide connectivity between US 79 and FM 3349/CR 101 in Williamson County, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the Williamson County Road and Bridge office at 3151 S. E. Inner Loop, Suite B, Georgetown, Texas 78626, and online at wilco.org/FM3349.
