



I-35 FROM SE INNER LOOP TO RM 1431 (SOUTHBOUND) OPEN HOUSE

Join us for an open house to discuss proposed improvements on I-35 from SE Inner Loop to RM 1431 (southbound) in Williamson County. Team members will be on hand to answer questions and provide information.

The purpose of the project is to improve safety and mobility by increasing visibility on the I-35 frontage roads at the intersections of SE Inner Loop and Westinghouse Road, and enhancing traffic flow by reducing lane merging/weaving between intersections and along the southbound mainlanes and frontage road. The following improvements are proposed:

- Reconstruct the intersections at I-35 and SE Inner Loop and Westinghouse Road
- Improve the existing I-35 southbound frontage road from north of SE Inner Loop to RM 1431
- Reverse entrance/exit ramps along the I-35 southbound frontage road between SE Inner Loop and RM 1431
- Improve bicycle and pedestrian sidewalks and paths
