Final Environmental Assessment Available for Public Review

Kenney Fort Boulevard – Segments 2 and 3 From Forest Creek Drive to State Highway 45

This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a final environmental assessment (EA) for the proposed Kenney Fort Boulevard – Segments 2 and 3 project, and that the final EA is available for public review. The proposed project would extend Kenney Fort Boulevard from Forest Creek Drive south to State Highway 45 in Williamson County, Texas.

The approved final EA is on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the City of Round Rock's Transportation Department, 3400 Sunrise Dr., Round Rock, Texas, 78665 (phone number: (512) 218-7044). Pursuant to 23 CFR 771.119(h), TxDOT will issue a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for this project no sooner than 30 days after the issuance of this notice of availability.
