



## Notice of Public Meeting

### In-Person and Virtual Open House

#### PARMER LANE (FM 734) CORRIDOR STUDY

#### FROM MOPAC (LOOP 1) TO WHITESTONE BOULEVARD (RANCH TO MARKET 1431)

#### Travis County and Williamson County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) are conducting a feasibility study to identify and evaluate potential improvements to Parmer Lane (Farm to Market 734) from MoPac (Loop 1) to Whitestone Boulevard (Ranch to Market 1431) in Travis and Williamson Counties.

This notice advises the public that CAMPO and TxDOT will be conducting an open house with both in-person and virtual options to participate to share safety and environmental data and engage the community in identifying potential improvements for the corridor.

**The in-person open house will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Wednesday, Dec. 13, 2023 at Northwest Family YCMA, 5807 McNeil Dr., Austin, TX 78729.** In-person participants are welcome to come and go any time from 5 to 7 p.m. and will be able to review project materials, ask questions of CAMPO and TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments.

**The virtual open house will consist of a self-guided virtual meeting room and will include both audio and visual components.** The virtual open house is **not** a live broadcast event and can be accessed online starting at 5 p.m. on Wednesday, Dec. 13, 2023, and will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated below through Friday, Jan. 19, 2024. The Parmer Lane Corridor Study will use public input and help CAMPO and TxDOT more clearly define and identify feasible options for improvements to Parmer Lane. This will include an analysis of previous plans and studies, current and projected traffic volumes, crash hotspots, environmental features, and needs and concerns identified in stakeholder and public input.

The in-person open house will be conducted in English. Project materials will be available in English and Spanish for both meeting formats. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the in-person or virtual open house, please contact the Parmer Lane Corridor Study Team at (512) 651-3964 no later than 4 p.m. CT, Friday, Dec. 8, 2023. Please be aware

that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for CAMPO and TxDOT to arrange.
