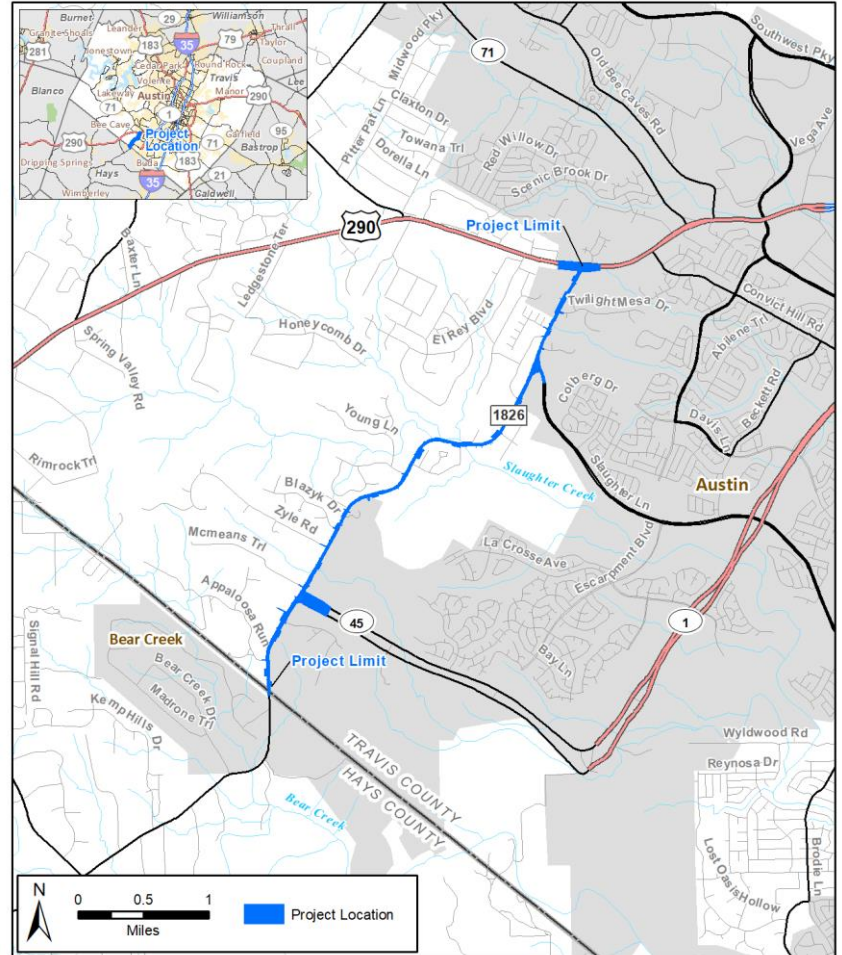

Project Overview

The proposed project would include the widening of an undivided two-lane roadway to a divided four-lane roadway (two travel lanes in each direction), with dedicated left-turn lanes and/or a four-foot-wide raised median. U-turns would be constructed at multiple locations throughout the length of the project. A 10-foot-wide shared-use path is proposed to accommodate bicyclists and pedestrians. Multiple water quality treatment ponds and vegetated filter strips are also proposed to comply with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality requirements. Intersection improvements are also proposed at Slaughter Lane and SH 45. The project is 4.4 miles in length and would require additional right of way, temporary construction easements, and drainage easements throughout.
