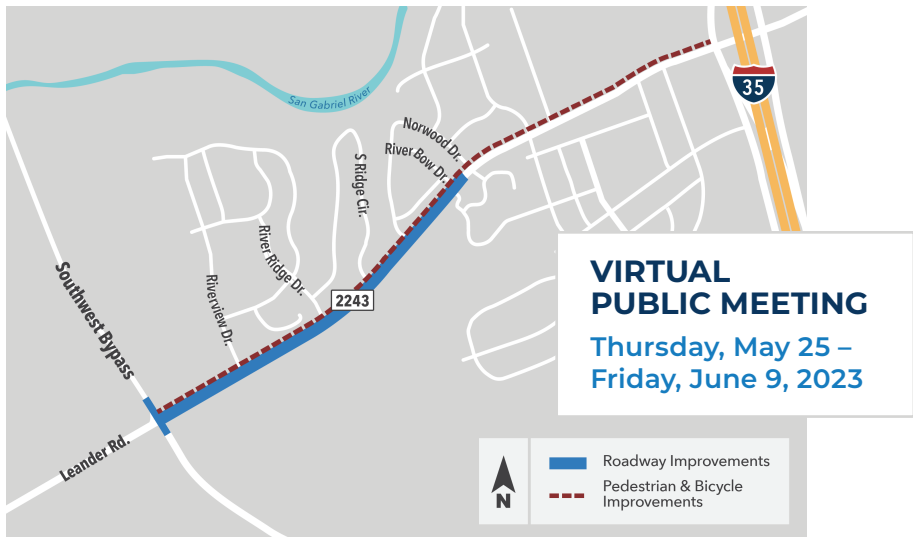


RM 2243 (Leander Road) Improvement Project

The City of Georgetown and the Texas Department of Transportation invite you to participate in a virtual public meeting to learn about proposed improvements to RM 2243 and share your input.




The proposed project includes safety and mobility improvements along RM 2243 from Southwest Bypass to Norwood Drive, as well as pedestrian and bicycle improvements from Southwest Bypass to the I-35 Frontage Road. Proposed improvements include widening RM 2243 to two lanes in each direction, constructing raised medians with turn lanes, and providing continuous pedestrian and bicycle paths. The project will also install a signal at RM 2243 and River Ridge Drive and reconstruct the Southwest Bypass intersection to be compatible with nearby project plans.


The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English.
