**RM 2243 (Leander Road) from Southwest Bypass to Norwood Drive

The City of Georgetown, in coordination with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), is proposing to improve RM 2243 (Leander Road) from Southwest Bypass to Norwood Drive in Williamson County, Texas. This notice advises the public that the City of Georgetown and TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project. The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be available online on Thursday, May 25, 2023, at 9 a.m.

To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above at bit.ly/Leander-Road. Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing until at least June 9, 2023, at 11:59 p.m. If you do not have internet access, you may call 512-533-9100 between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials at any time during the project development process. Formal comments may be provided by mail, email or voicemail as explained below.

The RM 2243 (Leander Road) project aims to enhance safety and mobility for vehicles, pedestrians, and cyclists and provide safe turning movements to and from local schools and subdivisions. Proposed improvements include widening RM 2243 (Leander Road) from Southwest Bypass to Norwood Drive to two lanes in each direction, constructing raised medians with turn lanes to reduce turning conflicts, and providing continuous pedestrian and bicyclist paths along RM 2243 from Southwest Bypass to the I-35 Frontage Road. The project would also install a signal at RM 2243 and River Ridge Drive and reconstruct the intersection of RM 2243 and Southwest Bypass to be compatible with nearby project plans.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential displacements are anticipated. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained by calling the project team at 512-887-2095.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. at Georgetown City Hall, 808 Martin Luther King Jr. St., Georgetown, Texas 78626. Project materials are also available online at bit.ly/Leander-Road.

The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator, one will be provided for you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting, please contact the project team at 512-887-2095 no later than 4 p.m. CT on May 22, 2023. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodation may require time to arrange.
