

SH 29 from RM 1431 to RM 2241

WHY IMPROVEMENTS ARE NEEDED

The Texas Department of Transportation Austin District is proposing improvements to SH 29 from RM 1431 to RM 2241 in Llano County, Texas. The proposed widening project is needed to improve safety and mobility on SH 29 by providing additional passing and turn lanes and shoulders.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project consists of widening SH 29 to add passing lanes, turn lanes and 10-foot shoulders. Improvements will provide safer passing of slower moving vehicles, safer turning with dedicated turn lanes and wider shoulders. The project would be separated into four phases to be completed over the next four years. All proposed construction would occur within the existing right of way.
