SH 71 at Ross Road and Kellam Road

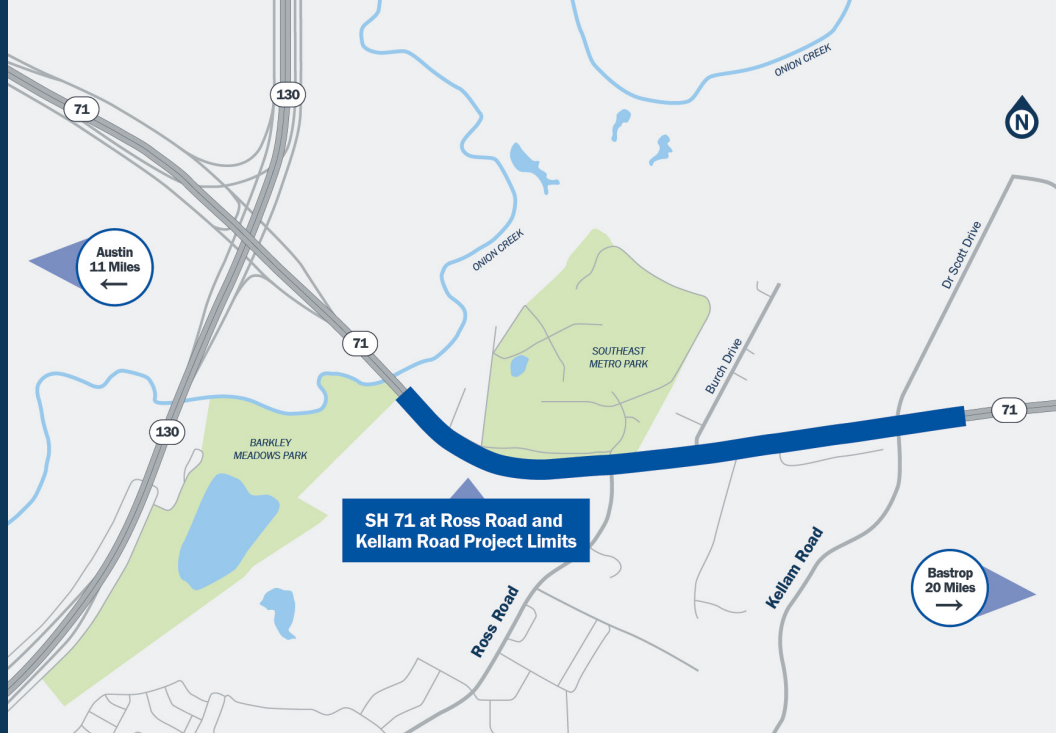

WHY IMPROVEMENTS ARE NEEDED

SH 71 serves as a major corridor for motorists traveling to and from the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport, the city of Bastrop, and other central Texas communities. With continued growth in eastern Travis and Bastrop counties, TxDOT is improving SH 71 to enhance safety and address congestion by eliminating signalized intersections.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project will construct two new overpass bridges on SH 71 over the existing signalized intersections at Ross Road and Kellam Road. This will improve mobility by allowing through-traffic on SH 71 to flow through the area without stopping. In addition, new frontage roads will be built within the project limits to allow local travelers access to Ross Road and Kellam Road. Bicycle and pedestrian accommodations will also be improved and expanded, as a part of this project.
