This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed US 79 Widening project, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would add a third travel lane in each direction of US 79 from I-35 to East of FM 1460 in Williamson County, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Austin District office located at 7901 N. I 35, Austin, Texas 78753, (512) 832-7387. They are also available online at [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov), keyword "US 79".
