At the request of the Giddings City Council and Lee County Commissioners Court, TxDOT has initiated the US 290 Giddings Mobility Study to develop and evaluate preliminary options to improve mobility, safety, and emergency response times and to address conflicts with the railroad in the City of Giddings in Lee County.
