From FM 2440 to SH 21

FACT SHEET



TxDOT is planning to construct roadway improvements to US 77 from FM 2440 to SH 21, in Lee County, Texas, a length of approximately eight miles.

Need for Improvements

There is a need to improve safety, mobility and operational efficiency. The proposed project would widen US 77 from an existing four-lane, undivided highway to a four-lane, divided highway with a grassy median.

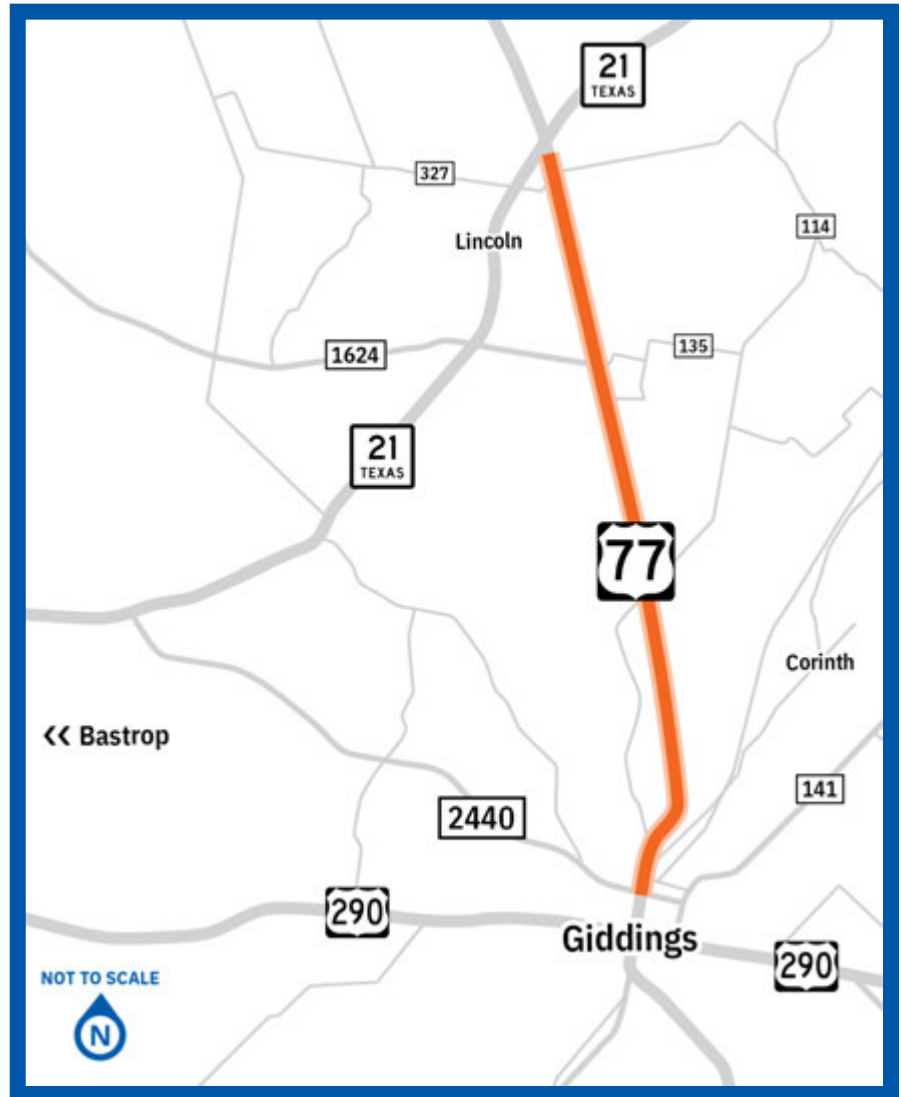
The improvements include replacing existing bridges at multiple locations, implementing the reduced conflict U-turn (RCUT) at intersections, adding new acceleration and deceleration lanes along the corridor, and constructing a new 10-foot-wide shared-use path on the west side of US 77 from West Independence Street to Giddings High School to facilitate and accommodate bicyclists and pedestrians.

Public Involvement

TxDOT is committed to working closely with the local community and stakeholders. The project team is taking all input received to date into account and this valuable feedback will be used to help finalize the project's design.
