### DAYTON SIDEWALKS ON SOUTH CLEVELAND, LOVERS LANE AND FM 1409

The Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") in coordination with the City of Dayton are proposing to construct sidewalks on South Cleveland, Lovers Lane and FM 1409 from Houston Street to Brown Road in Liberty County, Texas. This notice is affording an opportunity to comment as part of the environmental review process for this project. You are receiving this notice because records indicate you own property that would be acquired (in part or in whole) for this project.

The proposed project would construct sidewalks and curb ramps along South Cleveland, Lovers Lane and FM 1409 from Houston Street to south of Brown Road in Dayton. The purpose of this project is to promote safe travel for pedestrians between neighborhood schools. The sidewalk would be 1.344 miles in length.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time.
