



**Notice and Opportunity to Comment
MONT BELVIEU SIDEWALKS
VARIOUS LOCATIONS ALONG SH 146, EAGLE RIDGE DRIVE,
CHAMPIONS GATE DRIVE AND BROOKSTONE BOULEVARD

CHAMBERS County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) in coordination with the City of Mont Belvieu are proposing to construct sidewalks along portions of State Highway (SH) 146 Eagle Ridge Drive, Champions Gate Drive and Brookstone Boulevard in Chambers County, Texas. This notice is affording an opportunity to comment as part of the environmental review process for this project. You are receiving this notice because records indicate you own property that would be acquired (in part or in whole) for this project. This notice and opportunity to comment is also being provided to affected local governments and public officials.

The proposed project would construct sidewalks and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps along SH 146 from Warren Road south to the I-10 frontage road; 600-feet along Eagle Ridge Drive from Eagle Drive to the existing sidewalk in a private development; 570-feet along Champions Gate Drive from Eagle Drive to the existing sidewalk in a private development; and 400-feet along Brookstone Boulevard from Eagle Drive to the existing sidewalk in a private development. The sidewalk would be 6,000-feet in length. The curb ramps would offer enhanced safety for disabled.

Any environmental documentation or studies are available upon request from the district. Maps and drawings showing the project location and design, and other information regarding the proposed project, are available online at www.txdot.gov and Search: Mont Belvieu Sidewalks. If you do not have internet access, you may call 409-898-5834 to ask questions about the project and access project materials at any time during the project development process.

The project materials are written in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
