



**Notice of Online Comment Opportunity**  
**Texas Department of Transportation**  
**2021 - 2024 Rural Transportation Improvement Program Revision**  
**Beaumont District**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Beaumont District is conducting outreach to provide the public with an online comment opportunity for the proposed revision to the 2021-2024 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP). An in-person or virtual public meeting is not scheduled; however, the public is encouraged to view project information and submit comments about the revision by Monday, Feb. 1, 2021.

The purpose of the online comment opportunity is to receive comments on the revision to the 2021-2024 Rural TIP for the TxDOT Beaumont District. The projects that will be delayed by the revision include:

- US 69 Gateway to the Big Thicket, Tyler County – Widen from two to four lanes divided
- US 96 Widening, Jasper County – Widen from two to four lanes divided

The 2021-2024 Rural TIP meeting was held in the Spring pursuant to *Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102*, which calls for an opportunity for public comment concerning the program. As a continuation of the public involvement effort, the online comment opportunity will offer the public a chance to comment on the revision to the previously presented Rural TIP.
