



Notice of Virtual Public Meeting Texas Department of Transportation Available for Viewing on Thursday, May 12, 2022, by Noon 2023-2026 Rural Transportation Improvement Program Beaumont District

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will be conducting a virtual public meeting for the proposed 2023-2026 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP) for the Beaumont TxDOT District.

The virtual public meeting pre-recorded presentation will be available for viewing on Thursday, May 12, 2022, by noon. This virtual meeting format (no in-person meeting) includes a pre-recorded video presentation and comment opportunity. The Rural TIP materials will be available for viewing until the comment deadline below.

Pursuant to *Title 43 Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102*, this meeting is being held to receive comments on the 2023-2026 Rural TIP for the Beaumont TxDOT District. The Beaumont Rural TIP includes Tyler, Jasper, and Newton counties. The Rural TIP includes all regionally significant projects to be funded with FHWA/FTA, state or local funds in rural areas (outside the MPO area) during the next four years, including those eligible for federal funding. As such, these meetings offer the public an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed priorities. A project in the Rural TIP is a project coming to your community. The Rural TIP is the first step on the road to producing a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).
