

State Highway 105 Widening – Sour Lake

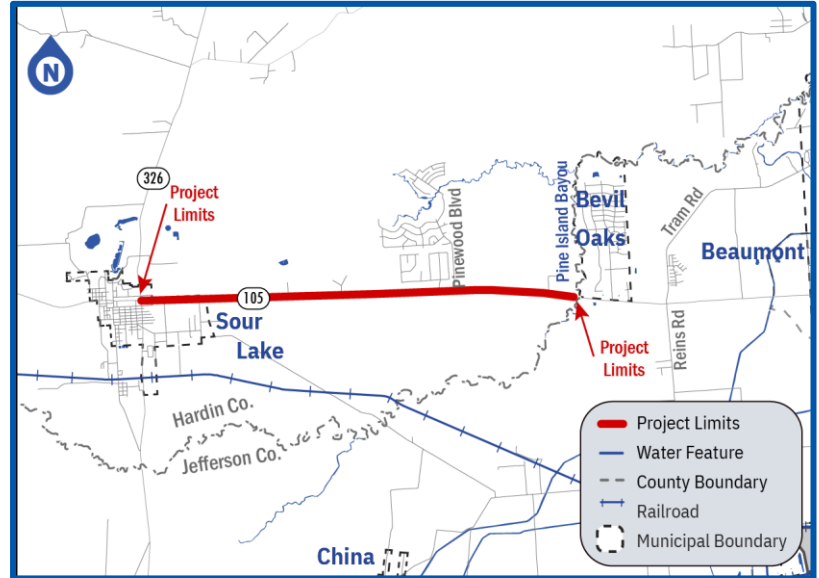
Overview

The TxDOT Beaumont District proposes improvements to SH 105 from 0.1 miles east of SH 326 to Pine Island Bayou in Hardin County, Texas.

The proposed project would:

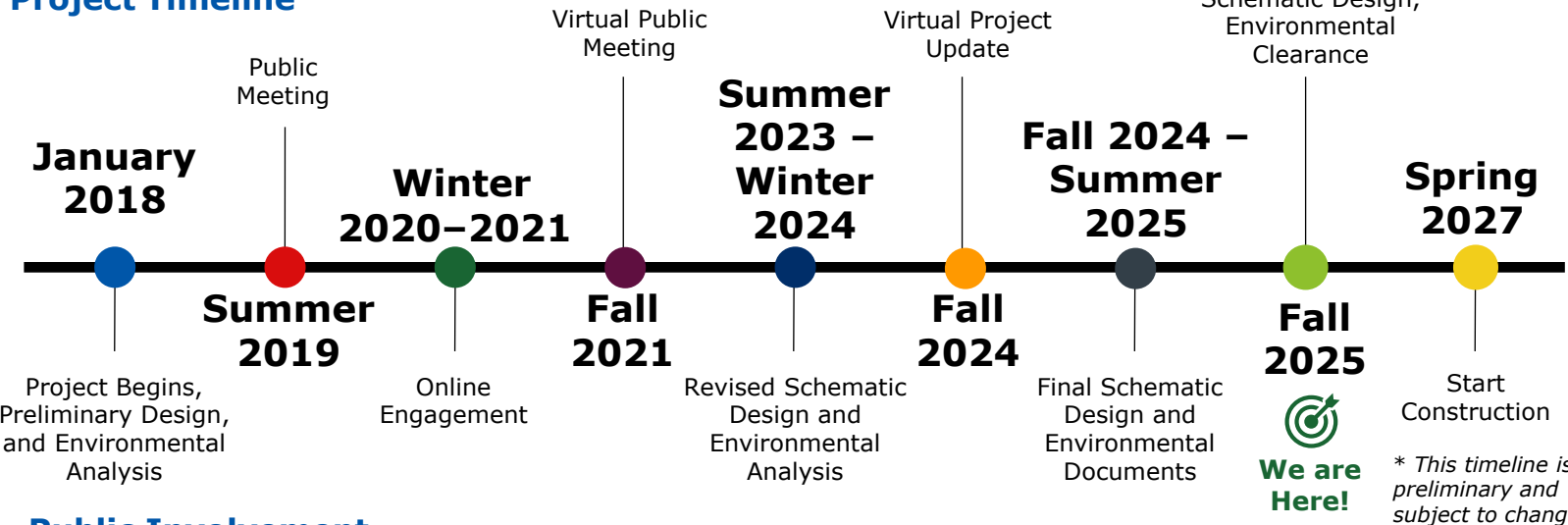
- Enhance traffic operations by reconstructing and expanding the existing two-lane undivided highway to a five-lane undivided highway.
- Improve safety by constructing new isolated raised center medians and improving multiple intersecting streets and driveway locations.
- Upgrade drainage by constructing three new detention basins.
- Require approximately 144.7 acres of additional right-of-way and 1.1 acres of temporary construction easements.

The purpose of public involvement is to provide information and gather input from the public. TxDOT is committed to working closely with the public to ensure that community members have the opportunity to comment, voice concerns, and ask questions. The preliminary public involvement schedule included public meetings and technical workgroup meetings from summer 2019 through summer 2025, and a virtual public hearing with in-person option in November 2025.
