**Finding of No Significant Impact
Available for Public Review**

US HWY 90 WIDENING

From FM 160, EAST to SH 61

Liberty County, Texas

This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed US 90 FM 160 E to SH 61 - Widening, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would reconstruct and widen from 2 to 4 lanes on US 90 from FM 160, EAST to SH 61 in Liberty County, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT-Beaumont District, 8350 Eastex Fwy, Beaumont, TX 77708, 409-892-7311.
