BS 36 (S. Day Street)/SH 36 Roadway Improvements
From 0.17 Miles North of US 290 to 0.27 Miles South of US 290
CSJ: 0187-01-054, 0187-01-060
Washington County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation – Bryan District is preparing plans to improve the roadway along BS 36 (S. Day Street) north of US 290 and SH 36 south of US 290 in Brenham, Washington County, Texas. The proposed project would improve traffic flow and reduce congestion near the US 290 intersection, provide access to businesses near the intersection, and enhance safety. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a public meeting on the proposed project.

The meeting will be held on **Thursday, March 19, 2026, from 4:30 pm to 6:30 p.m. at Blinn College – Student Center, 1007 Walter Schwartz Way, Brenham, Texas 77833**. Attendees will be able to come and go as they please to review informational displays and ask questions of staff in an open house format. The purpose of the meeting is to present the proposed project and receive public comments. On the day of the public meeting, the information presented will be made available online on the TxDOT website, www.txdot.gov, keyword search "BS 36/SH 36 Improvements".

The proposed roadway improvements would extend and reconfigure the existing medians along S. Day Street north of US 290 and SH 36 south of US 290. The existing medians would be extended by an additional 555 ft to the north and 660 ft to the south. The goal of the project is to improve traffic flow and reduce congestion near the US 290 intersection, provide access to businesses near the intersection, and enhance safety. TxDOT does not anticipate any right-of-way acquisition for this project.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection, by appointment only, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Bryan District Office, 2591 North Earl Rudder Freeway, Bryan, Texas, 77803, (979) 778-2165.

The public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
