

# Open House Public Meeting

## FM 60 at UPRR in Deanville Burleson County

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), as the Lead Agency, is proposing to improve FM 60 at the UPRR in Deanville, TX. An informal open house is scheduled for Thursday, August 23, between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the Deanville VFD Station in Deanville, TX. TxDOT staff will display proposed alternatives and be available to discuss the project.

Existing FM 60 from FM 111 to approximately 0.25-miles northwest of the UPRR consists of two 11-foot lanes (one in each direction) with 4-foot outside shoulders within a 80 to 100-foot right-of-way (ROW). FM 60 at UPRR is grade separated and FM 60 passes under UPRR with a 13-foot 4-inch clearance. The UPRR bridge at FM 60 is wood bridge with wood retaining walls.

Alternative one consists of widening existing FM 60 within the project limits to two 12-foot lanes (one in each direction) with 10-foot outside shoulders. FM 60 would pass under UPRR and the existing UPRR profile would be maintained. The wood retaining walls at the bridge would be replaced with concrete retaining walls. In addition, retaining walls would be constructed on the north and south side of FM 60, from the UPRR bridge to approximately 500-feet from the intersection of FM 60 and FM 111. Dead-end, two-way access roads would be constructed on the north and south side of the FM 60 to provide access to the properties located between FM 111 and the UPRR bridge.

Alternative two consists of widening existing FM 60 within the project limits to two 12-foot lanes (one in each direction) with 10-foot outside shoulders. An approximate 720-foot bridge would be constructed allowing FM 60 to pass over the existing UPRR bridge. The UPRR bridge would maintain the existing profile. The wood retaining walls at the bridge would be replaced with concrete retaining walls. In addition, retaining walls would be constructed on the north and south side of FM 60, at both the east and west ends of the proposed FM 60 within the project limits. A one-way access road would be constructed on the north and south side of FM 60 to provide access to the properties located between FM 111 and the UPRR bridge. The access road would pass under FM 60 with a U-turn.

Interested citizens are invited to attend and may come and go at their convenience. Updated meeting displays will be available for viewing on the web page after the public meeting. Displays showing the design and other information regarding the project are also available for inspection at the District Office Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Currently, the proposed project alternatives would require additional right-of-way of approximately 1.1 acres for alternative 1 and 1 acres for alternative 2 and would relocate/displace one residences/businesses or commercial structures. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance

Program, benefits and services for displacements, as well as information about the tentative schedules for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT Bryan District Office at the address listed below. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses.
