Inner Loop East Study
From SH 6 at FM 2818 to William D Fitch Parkway 1.8 miles south of SH 30
CSJ: 0917-00-079
Brazos County, Texas**

Brazos County is studying the feasibility of a potential new roadway that would connect the eastern areas of Bryan and College Station. Should the study determine a new roadway is needed, it would enhance north-south connectivity and roadway capacity for east Brazos County to meet future local and regional mobility needs. Additionally, the purpose of the proposed new roadway is to improve north-south connectivity, mobility, and roadway capacity to accommodate traffic volume growth associated with new and future planned development.

This notice advises the public that Brazos County will be hosting an in-person and virtual open house on the proposed project.

The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, May 6, 2025, from 5 to 7 p.m. at Legends Event Center, 2533 Midtown Park Blvd, Bryan, Texas 77801**. Attendees will be able to come and go as they please to review project displays and ask questions of study team and/or consultants in an open house format. The purpose of the meeting is to present refined alignment concepts and receive public comments. On the day of the public meeting, the information presented will be made available online on the following webpage and will remain online for at least 30 days: www.brazoscountytexas.gov/653/Inner-Loop-East.

If you do not have internet access, you may call 979-383-2036 between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Brazos County is in the process of collecting and analyzing data to identify feasible options for a new roadway alignment approximately 20 miles in length. The proposed loop alignment would connect to SH 6 at FM 2818 in Bryan then continue southward and connect with William D Fitch Parkway in College Station. The meeting will present information including the goals of the project, background, need and purpose, refined alternative alignment concepts, traffic modeling, and next steps.

Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative project development schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the Brazos County Offices, 300 E 26th Street, Bryan, TX 77803, 979-775-7400. Project materials will also be available online at www.brazoscountytexas.gov/653/Inner-Loop-East.
