



**Notice of Virtual Public Meeting
Texas Department of Transportation
2025–2028 Rural Transportation Improvement Program November 2025 Revision
Bryan District**

The Texas Department of Transportation – Bryan District will conduct an online virtual pre-recorded public meeting for the 2025–2028 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP) November 2025 Revision which includes Leon, Madison, Walker, and Washington Counties. The Bryan District includes Brazos, Burleson, Freestone, Grimes, Leon, Madison, Milam, Robertson, Walker, and Washington counties. The Rural TIP includes all added capacity and regionally significant projects to be funded within a TxDOT District during the fiscal years 2025-2028, including those eligible for federal funding.

The purpose of this meeting is to inform the public of significant changes to the 2025-2028 Rural TIP. The projects affected by these revisions in Madison County represent the SH 21 Madisonville Relief Route (SL 1853), including a new interchange at IH 45 and SL 1853. SH 21 Madisonville Relief Route (SL 1853) has been separated into two lettings.

The SL 1853 segment from SH 90 to IH 45 and IH 45 interchange projects are scheduled to let in fiscal year 2027. This project has been allocated additional funds for construction bringing the total authorized amount for construction to \$225,637,288 for these two segments.

The SL 1853 segments from SH 21 to 0.3 miles E of SH 90 and from IH 45 to SH 21 are being removed from the 2025-2028 Rural TIP. The project is still being developed. However, these segments will not begin construction in the FY 2025-2028 timeframe.
