

SH 6/US 79 Hearne Relief Route Study

Background and Introduction

TxDOT - Bryan District is currently studying the feasibility of a relief route around the City of Hearne to alleviate congestion and enhance safety. Proposed relief route segments would provide an alternative route with connections to US 79, US 190 and SH 6. A potential relief route would require acquisition of new right of way.

Traffic Patterns

The feasibility study is evaluating three potential relief route segments: South (3.6 miles), West (5.1 miles), and East (6.3 miles).

- Over 5,600 vehicles per day enter the Hearne area from the north using SH 6. About 77% travel through Hearne to SH 6 South.
- Over 9,800 vehicles per day enter the Hearne area from the south using SH 6. About 45% travel through Hearne to SH 6 North.

Project Goals

- Enhance Safety:** A relief route would provide a safe and reliable roadway that meets current design standards.
- Improve Mobility:** A relief route would increase roadway capacity and allow traffic to move easily, without restrictions through the Hearne area.
- Reduce Congestion:** A relief route would reduce through traffic, especially freight, in Hearne.
