This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed US 290 at SH 36 interchange project, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would construct a new interchange at the intersection of US 290 and SH 36 from FM 389 (Prairie Lea Street) to CR 49 (Windy Acres Road) in Washington County, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Bryan District Office, 2591 North Earl Rudder Freeway, Bryan, Texas 77803, (979) 778-9231.
