Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option
I-20 RAMPS CISCO
EASTLAND County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is hosting a meeting to discuss I-20 ramps and the feasibility of relocation of ramps within the Cisco area, Eastland County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on this subject with an in-person option. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Aug. 4 at 12:00 p.m.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: **TxDOT.gov and Search I-20 Ramps Cisco**. Following the virtual public meeting, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until Monday Aug. 22, 2022, at 11:59 p.m. If you do not have internet access, you may call Jason Scantling at (325) 643-0415 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants from a socially distanced approach, and leave written comments. **The in-person option will be held on Thursday, Aug. 4, 2022, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Cisco ISD Cafeteria, 1300 Pershing St., Cisco, TX 76437. This meeting will present the exact same materials available online.**

The proposed meeting is to discuss feasibility of ramp relocations on I-20 within the Cisco area. TxDOT hopes to obtain feedback from the public on perceived needs regarding exit/entry ramps on I-20 within the Cisco area.

A project has not been identified at this time, but if a project is determined to be warranted after receiving public feedback; information regarding a proposed project will be on file and made available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Brownwood District Office, 2495 HWY 183 N, Brownwood, Texas 76802 and (325) 643-0415. Project materials would also be made available online by going to TxDOT.gov and Searching **I-20 Ramps Cisco**. Any presented materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person option.

The virtual public meeting and in-person option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
