

NOTICE OF VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING

2027 – 2030 Rural TIP

Brownwood District

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Brownwood District will conduct an online virtual public meeting for the proposed 2027 – 2030 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP). The purpose of this meeting is to provide information and receive comments on which transportation projects may be coming to your area. Brownwood District includes Brown, Coleman, McCulloch, Lampasas, Mills, San Saba, Stephens, Eastland, and Comanche counties. The RTIP includes both grouped projects and individually listed projects that include added-capacity projects and regionally significant projects funded outside of Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) boundary, and within a TxDOT district during the next four years, including those eligible for federal funding. This meeting offers the public an opportunity to review and comment on proposed priorities. RTIP is the first step on the road to producing the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The virtual public meeting will be available on txdot.gov by Monday, Apr. 13 through Monday, Apr. 27, keyword search "Brownwood Rural TIP." The public will have an opportunity to watch a prerecorded presentation, review exhibits, and comment on the proposed revision during this time.

The RTIP meeting is being held pursuant to Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102, which calls for an opportunity for public comment concerning the program. Written comments are requested and must be received by Monday, Apr. 27, 2026, to be included in the official public meeting record.
