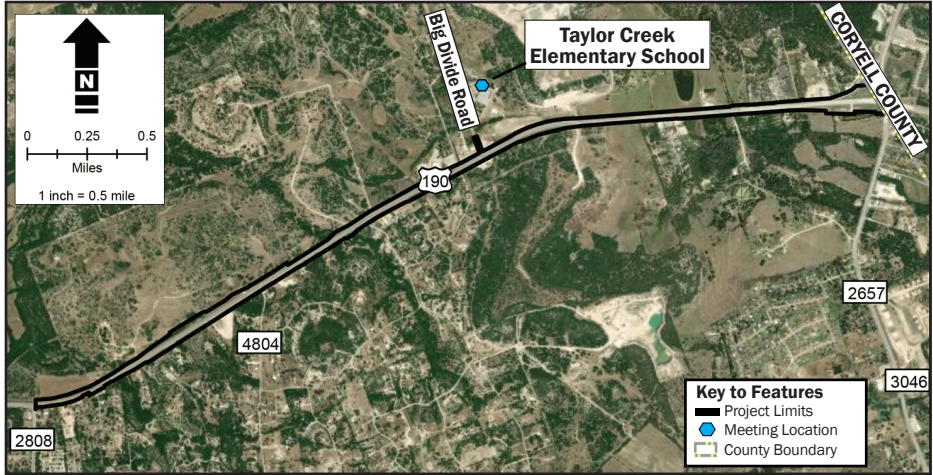
VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING WITH IN-PERSON OPTION
