The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Childress District is proposing the rehabilitation of SH 256 from FM 2361, East to US 287 in Hall County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a public meeting on the proposed project. The meeting will be held on April 18, 2022, at the Memphis Community Center, 721 Robertson Street, Memphis, Texas, 79245, from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. Displays will be available for viewing after the formal presentation. The purpose of the meeting is to present the proposed project and receive public comment.

The proposed improvements of this project include rehabilitating the roadway, installing new sidewalk, curb and gutter, and ADA ramps, as well as upgrading existing drainage facilities and reutilizing the existing historic brick in the downtown area.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Childress District Office, 7599 US 287, Childress, Texas 79201, (940) 937-7189. This information also will be available for inspection at the meeting.

The public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the Texas Department of Transportation to arrange.

Written comments from the public regarding the proposed project are requested and may be presented at the meeting. Responses to comments received will be on file and available for inspection at the TxDOT Childress District Office once they have been prepared.
