



Notice of a Virtual Open House with In-Person Option

FM 624 (Northwest Boulevard) from Wildcat Drive to CR 73 CSJ: 0989-02-057 | Nueces County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing improvements to FM 624 (Northwest Boulevard) from Wildcat Drive to CR 73 in Corpus Christi, Nueces County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will conduct an online virtual open house on the proposed project with an in-person option. **The virtual open house will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Thursday, Nov. 2, 2023, by 5 p.m.** To visit the virtual open house, go to www.txdot.gov, keyword search "FM 624" at the date and time indicated above.

Following the virtual open house, the presentation will remain available for viewing at the web address indicated above until at least Monday, Nov. 20, 2023, at 11:59 p.m. If you do not have internet access, you may call (361) 808-2509 between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online open house, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. **The in-person option will be held on Thursday, Nov. 2, 2023, from 5 to 7 p.m., at Calallen High School, Cafeteria, 4001 Wildcat Dr., Corpus Christi, TX 78410.**

TxDOT is proposing improvements to FM 624 (Northwest Boulevard) from Wildcat Drive to CR 73 in Corpus Christi, Nueces County, a length of approximately 3 miles. The proposed project would widen the roadway to accommodate three continuous travel lanes in each direction, turn lanes, and a 10-ft shared use path/sidewalk. The existing raised center median along FM 624 (Northwest Boulevard) would be modified and extended to CR 73. All improvements would be constructed within existing right of way.

In consideration of these proposed improvements, TxDOT is reviewing traffic data, local and regional access needs, safety, potential environmental impacts, and is seeking public input. There will be several opportunities for the public to provide input during the development of this project.

Information regarding the proposed project is on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Corpus Christi Office, 1701 S. Padre Island Drive, Corpus Christi, TX 78416, (361) 808-2660. Project materials are also available online at www.txdot.gov, keyword search "FM 624." These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person option.

The virtual open house and in-person option will be conducted in English, with Spanish materials available online and in-person. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual open house or in-person option, leave a message at (361) 808-2544 no later than 4 p.m. CT, three business

days before the in-person option is held. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for TxDOT to arrange.
