1	Nancy Janak (representing myself as a driver)	4/25/19	Comment Card	I live in Odem and drive to and from work over the bridge. My concern is about congestion when construction begins on the project. Please warn all drivers early and keep us safe on the road. Thanks. Look forward to the new bridge and road access. Look forward to a safer commute between 77, 37, and the bridge.	Comment noted. TxDOT is in the early stages of design for the proposed project. The work is anticipated to be constructed in phases, and at least three lanes of traffic in each direction would remain open during all phases of construction. If additional lane closures become necessary, these would be for the shortest periods necessary to complete the work and would likely occur during low traffic volumes such as late at night or early in the morning.
2	Jim Wilkins	4/25/19	Comment Card	When the contractors bid on the bridge over the Nueces River (do not bid low on the materials) [due] to the river is salt water in the low tide high tide cycle in that area rust [resistant] rebar [is] a must because the price of this next time will double or triple.	Comment noted. The proposed project would include replacing the bridges over the Nueces River with higher, wider bridges that would be more resilient to storm events and the coastal environment.

Speed limits are established according to current TxDOT design standards. Following project construction, a speed study would be completed to set the posted speed limits.
