Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP)

THE RURAL TIP

is a list of all added capacity and regionally significant projects to be funded within a TxDOT district during the 4-year program window, including those eligible for federal funding.

Projects can be multimodal and may include studies and/or construction for:

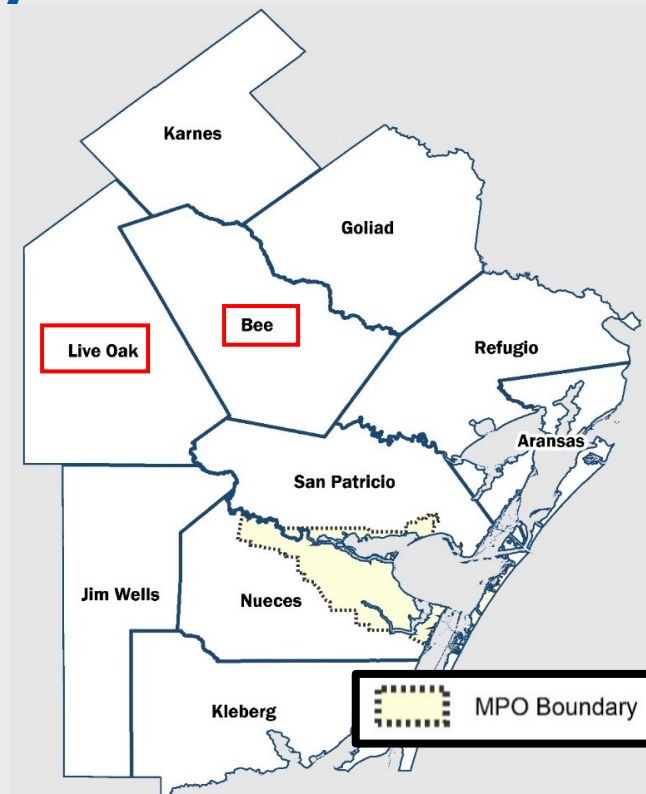


A Rural TIP project is anticipated to be funded within the 4-year program window.

It shows regional agreement (community-region-state) on the need of a project.

Corpus Christi District Rural TIP February Revision

- In May 2024, a Virtual Public Meeting explained the Rural Transportation Improvement Program and presented the 2025-2028 proposed district projects.
- The Rural TIP program, as presented in May, is being revised.
- Counties affected by the revision include:
 - Live Oak County
 - Bee County
- This Online Comment Opportunity gives the public a chance to provide input on the revision.



Why is the Rural TIP being revised?

- Due to statewide funding considerations, two projects originally scheduled for fiscal year 2028 are being removed from the Rural TIP and are now planned for fiscal year 2030. The two projects are:
 - CSJ 0447-01-046, US 59 in Live Oak County
 - CSJ 0447-02-037, US 59 in Bee County
- These projects are anticipated to be part of the future I-69 corridor. The proposed projects would widen portions of US 59 to a 4-lane divided highway by constructing two additional travel lanes.
- As part of ongoing public involvement, TxDOT is providing the Rural TIP changes for public comment.

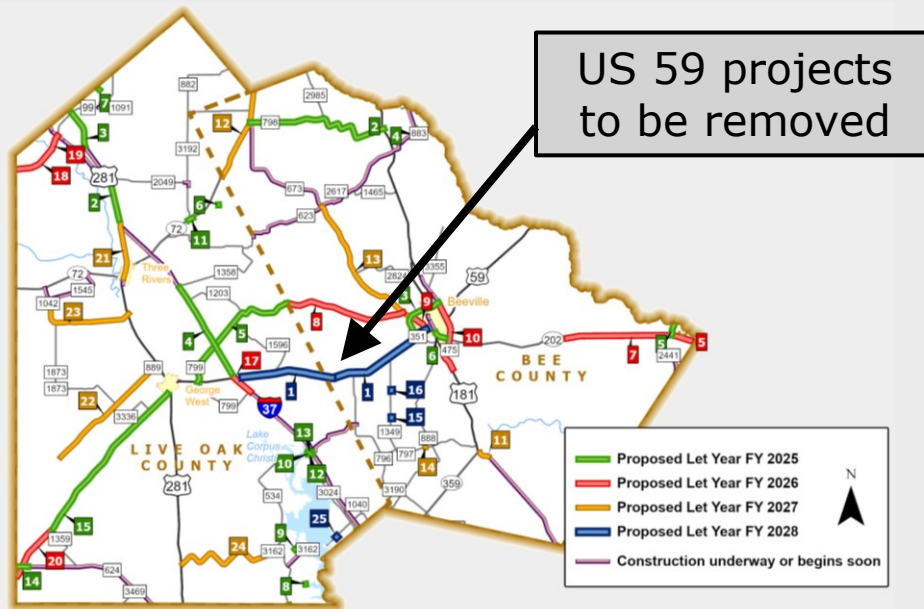
The following slide will highlight the projects and schedules that will be affected by the 2025-2028 Rural TIP February Revision for the Corpus Christi District.

Two Regionally Significant Projects will be Removed

US 59 Live Oak County

US 59 Bee County

This map shows the two projects originally scheduled for fiscal year 2028 that are being removed from the current Rural TIP. The projects are now planned for fiscal year 2030. Together, the two projects are anticipated to be part of the future I-69 corridor.
