RURAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The public is invited to participate in an open house and public meeting to offer feedback on proposed future improvements for highways in Aransas, Bee, Goliad, Jim Wells, Karnes, Kleberg, Live Oak, Nueces, Refugio, and San Patricio counties in the Rural Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

The Rural TIP is both a funding process and a funding document. The Rural TIP projects for these counties are planned for construction over the next four years. This is an opportunity to give input to which projects are a priority or concern to you.

TxDOT is responsible for selecting projects for funding programs. While the local TxDOT District is responsible for selecting projects with various funding sources at the district level, the Texas Transportation Commission (TTC), which serves as the policy-making body for TxDOT, then selects all other projects on a statewide competitive basis. The projects selected under each of the relevant funding categories are listed in the Rural TIP.

The full Rural TIP draft document is available for review from the TxDOT Corpus Christi District Office, the four District Area Offices (Corpus Christi, Sinton, Alice and Karnes City), and the 11 District Maintenance Offices (Alice, Beeville, Corpus Christi, George West, Goliad, Karnes City, Kingsville, Refugio, Robstown, Rockport, and Sinton).
