



**TxDOT Open House on Improvements to SH 286
December 7, 2017**

On December 7, 2017, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Corpus Christi District will hold a public open house to provide information and answer questions about a proposed project to improve State Highway (SH) 286 from Farm-to-Market (FM) 43 to south of FM 2444 in Nueces County. The proposed project is approximately 3.4 miles long and is located southwest of the City of Corpus Christi. TxDOT is proposing to convert this section of SH 286 from a two-lane undivided highway to a four-lane divided rural highway, with a future option of becoming a six-lane highway if needed.

The proposed project is needed to accommodate anticipated future growth in the area, to provide connectivity to other roadways in the region, and facilitate access to major evacuation routes.

Time: 5:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m.

Format: Open house to meet the project team, learn about the proposed project, review the recommended alternative, ask questions and provide comments on the proposed project.

The public open house will be conducted in English.
