

SH 361 MUSTANG ISLAND PROJECT FROM ACCESS ROAD 1 TO PARK ROAD 22

PROJECT PROFILE SEPTEMBER 2024

Mustang Island and North Padre Island, located in Nueces County, are home to permanent year-round residents and many seasonal visitors. TxDOT is studying SH 361 in Nueces county from Access Road 1 to Park Road 22 to identify potential traffic safety and mobility improvements along this approximate 15-mile corridor. The proposed project would widen SH 361 to a four-lane highway with two travel lanes in each direction, add raised center medians with left turn lanes as needed, and consider the addition of a sidewalk/shared use path.




CURRENT STATUS

The SH 361 Mustang Island Project will follow the project development process shown below. Preliminary design and environmental studies are underway. The environmental study process includes gathering information on potential endangered species, wetlands, park properties, community resources, historical/archeological resources, and traffic noise. Schematic design includes identifying design concepts that will consider traffic flow, safety, and future growth. Connectivity off the island during major weather events must also be considered.
