



Notice of Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option

SH 361 MUSTANG ISLAND PROJECT

From Access Road 1 to Park Road 22

CSJ 2263-03-024 | Nueces County, Texas

TxDOT's Corpus Christi District is proposing improvements to SH 361 from Access Road 1 to Park Road 22 in Nueces County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will conduct a virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person option. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Thursday, Sept. 19 at 4:30 p.m., and will remain online for at least 15 days.** To view the virtual public meeting on the date and time indicated above, visit www.txdot.gov and use the keyword search "SH 361 Mustang Island."

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. The in-person option will be held in an open house format with attendees welcome to come and go at their convenience. In-person attendees can view the same pre-recorded presentation delivered in the online public meeting, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. There will not be a live presentation at the in-person event. **The in-person option will be held on Thursday, Sept. 19, 2024, from 4:30 - 6:30 p.m., at Island in the Sun United Methodist Church, 10650 SH 361, Corpus Christi, TX 78418.**

The proposed project would widen SH 361 to a four-lane highway with two travel lanes in each direction, raised center medians with left turn lanes as needed, and a sidewalk/shared use path. The proposed project is approximately 15 miles in length and would be designed to improve safety and mobility along SH 361. Additional right of way (ROW) is anticipated to be needed. The project is in the preliminary stage of design and input from the public is being requested before potential ROW impacts are identified.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time.

The proposed project would involve an action in a floodplain with some construction anticipated to occur in wetlands.

Information regarding the proposed project is on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Corpus Christi District Office, 1701 S. Padre Island Drive, Corpus Christi, TX 78416, or by calling 361-808-2509. Meeting materials are available online at www.txdot.gov, keyword search "SH 361 Mustang Island." These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person option.

The virtual public meeting and in-person option will be conducted in English, with Spanish materials available online and in person. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. Call Rickey Dailey at 361-808-2544 no later than 4 p.m. Monday, Sept. 16, 2024, to

request special accommodations. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for TxDOT to arrange.
