



US 281 ALICE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARING WITH IN-PERSON OPTION

The primary purpose of the proposed project is to improve safety and mobility by upgrading US 281 in Alice to interstate standards. The project would upgrade the existing 4-lane divided highway, to a 4-lane divided freeway. The existing roadways would become the frontage roads. Three overpasses are proposed for construction over the following roadways: CR 116 , CR 117 and CR 129. A north and south-bound bridge would be constructed over San Diego Creek. On ramps and exit ramps would be added and some existing ramps would be reversed. No additional right-of-way would be required for this proposed project.

All members of the public are invited to view the project information, ask questions, and provide comments on the proposed project.
