Finding of No Significant Impact Available for Public Review

US 77 SINTON IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed US 77 Sinton Improvement Project, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would upgrade U.S. Highway (US) 77 from a 4-lane divided highway to a 4-lane divided freeway from Business (BU) 77 South to BU North in San Patricio County, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the Corpus Christi District Office at 1701 S. Padre Island Drive, Corpus Christi, Texas 78416, by phone at (361) 808-2660. They are also available online at txdot.gov keyword search "US 77 Sinton Improvement"
