The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Corpus Christi District, in coordination with Refugio County, is continuing the project development process for the US Highway (US) 77 improvements in the Woodsboro and Refugio area. The US 77 Woodsboro Refugio Improvement project would upgrade the existing US 77 to interstate standards along the existing route near the City of Woodsboro and construct a new US 77 roadway to interstate standards east of the City of Refugio. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online open house on the proposed project with two in-person options.
